Representing U.S., Greek, and international companies operating in Greece, AmCham Greece is dedicated to fostering a robust, growth-oriented business and investment climate in the country. It is a wholly autonomous, not-for-profit organization that operates without any government subsidies. AmCham Greece is an active member of both the U.S. Chamber of Commerce in Washington, D.C., and since 2023, serves as the AmChams in Europe network's Secretariat, taking on this pivotal role for the umbrella organization that represents 50 American Chambers of Commerce from 48 countries across Europe and Eurasia.
