Kinnaird went on to become a Technical Director, Stage Manager, Company Manager and Theatre Director as well as associate producer on his first Off Broadway show working with Tony award winning producer, John Wulp on Red Eye of Love in 2014 to rave reviews by the New York Times (who never reviews Off Broadway shows). As creator and book writer, Kinnaird took a new fantasy musical, Chasing Innocence, the musical to win awards at the West Village Musical Theatre Festival in 2016 and the new sci-fi musical is still in development. An Off Broadway staged reading of 13 Alabama Ghosts, Kinnaird produced the musical in 2017 to rave reviews and creative are still working with Kinnaird to move the production forward.

In 2019, Kinnaird became a children's book author when his new children's book series Tony the Theatre Dog was ranked among the top 20k books on Amazon out of 8 million titles. His children's book has received multiple 5-star reviews by children's book critiques.
